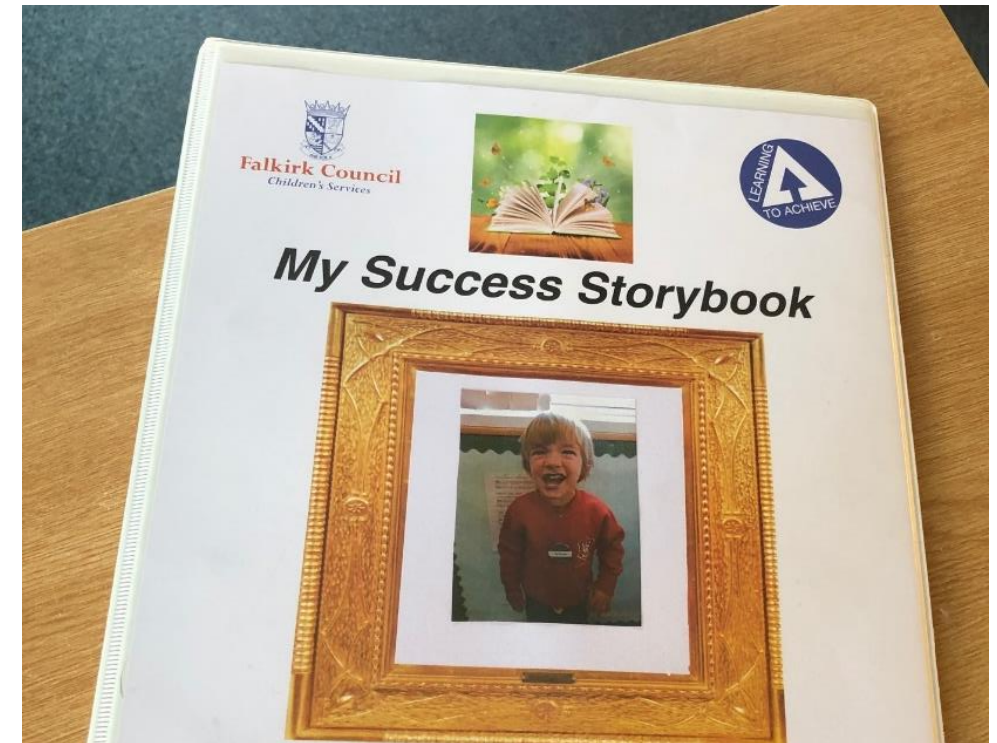


Absence and Medication

- Phone the ELC Class direct if you need to speak to someone 01324 506768.
- Please state the reason for absence.
- 48 hour rule if child shows signs of sickness or diarrhoea – help us avoid spread of infections.
- If your child requires medication at ELC this has to be brought to ELC in original box/ packet with prescription label on.

Clothing

- Many of our ELC Class activities can be messy, so please bear this in mind when dressing your child for Nursery.
- Formal school uniform is not necessary and are not the best type of clothing for an active day in nursery.
- Loose, comfortable clothing such as t-shirt, joggers/leggings and a sweatshirt allow children ease of movement. Please start encouraging your child to be an independent dresser now.
- Children have access to the outdoors on a daily basis ALL YEAR and require a suitable jacket and waterproof trousers for outdoors depending on the season. Summer jackets should be shower proof and have a hood. In winter a hat, gloves and warm coat are required. Outdoor shoes should be suitable for climbing, riding a bike etc. and should offer grip on a wet surface. **Please avoid laces unless your child can do their own.**
- **PLEASE LABEL ALL YOUR CHILD'S CLOTHING INCLUDING SHOES.**

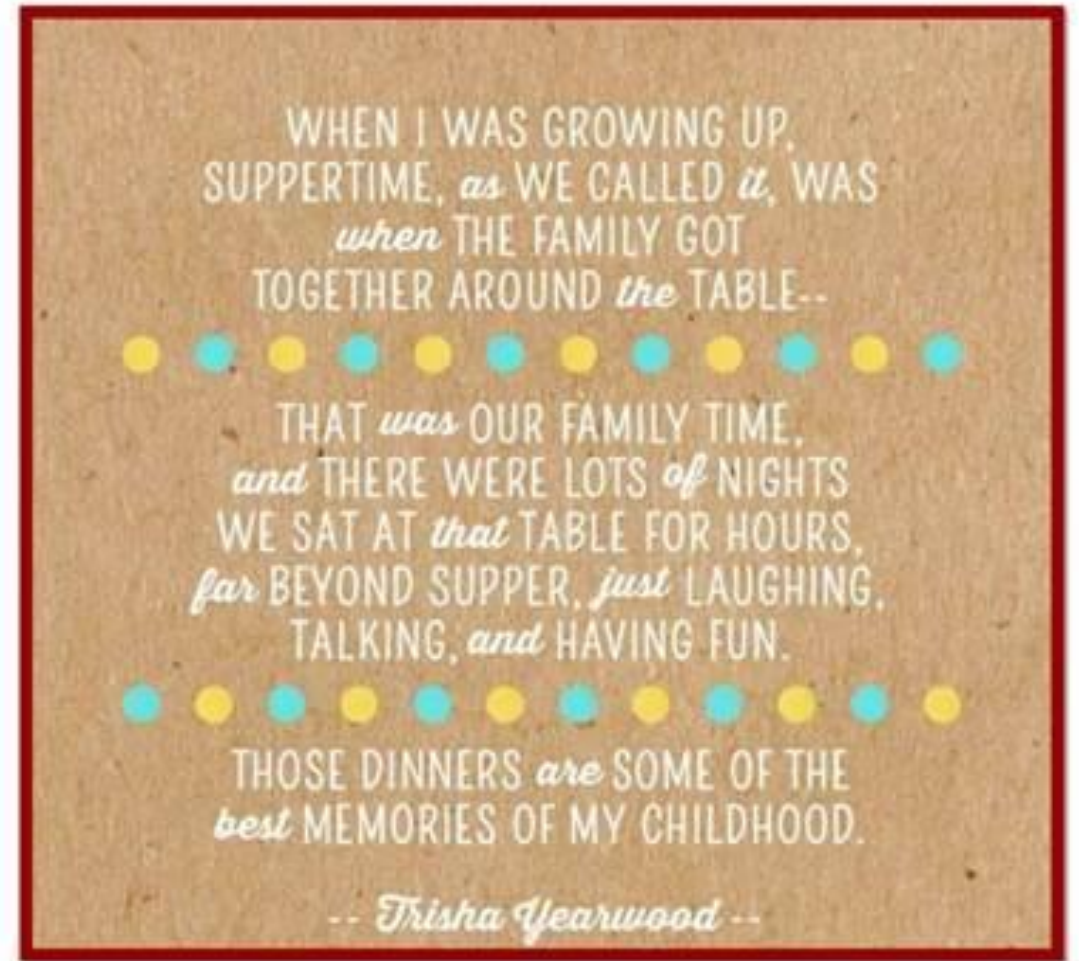

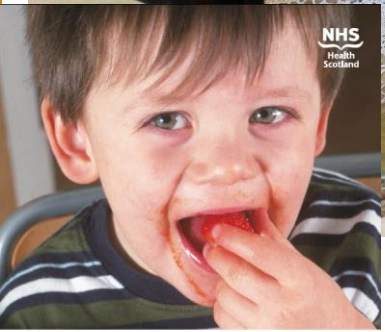

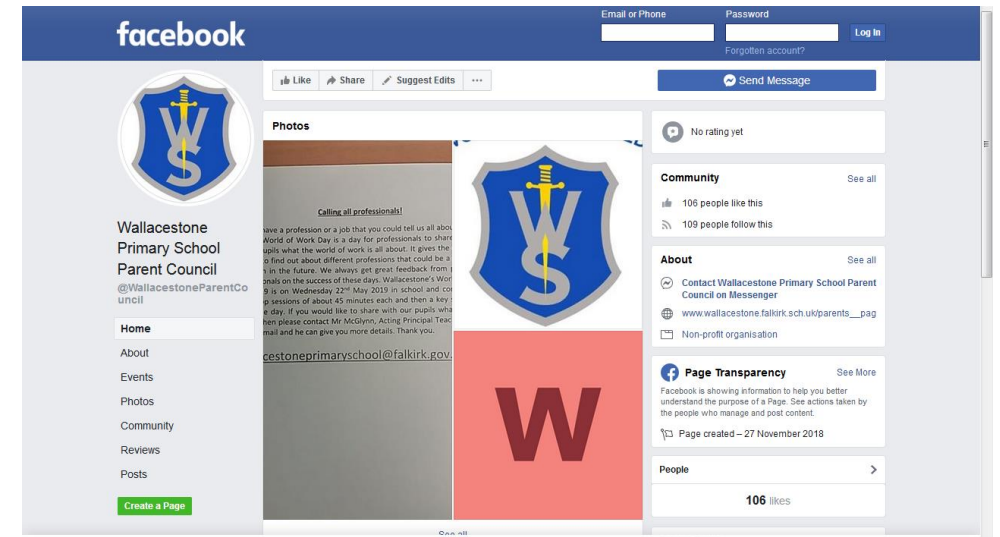
