Opportunities for personal achievement

Each term we are focusing on some of the wider skills for learning, life and work as a way to recognise and help children make personal achievements.

- Children will learn about building and maintaining positive relationships.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term our children in Primary 6 are basing their IDL on Superheroes.

- Primary 6 children have come together to discuss ways they can be heroes in their local community.
- We thought about food and toy banks as well as raising funds for local groups.
- Visits from those who support people in need in our community are planned.

The Curriculum

Each term we will plan opportunities for how we contribute to the ethos and life of the school as a community.

- Children will participate in decision making by creating a Class Charter linked to the UNCRC and Global Goals.
- Children will be taking part in our whole school superhero focus where every child will be focusing on growth mind-set, high expectations and helping to improve the local community.
- Children will refresh their knowledge of the Emotion Works programme and be able to name emotions, recognise triggers, regulate big feelings and develop resilience.

Literacy:

- Within literacy children will be focusing on the six main reading strategies. They will also be reading and creating descriptive settings.

Numeracy:

- The children will focus on place value, rounding and the four main number processes.

Health and Wellbeing

- This term Primary 6 will focus on emotional regulation using emotion works, growth mind-set and online safety.

French

- Within French this term we will be focusing on numbers to 100, greetings and classroom objects.

Expressive arts

- Children will be learning about primary, secondary and tertiary colours. They will also be creating mixed media art projects. They will also be taking part in a variety of drama lessons focusing on listening to instructions and performing in front of small audiences
