Interdisciplinary Learning

Learning for Sustainability – Right Respecting School UNCRC

This Term we will be using our 'Learning for Sustainability' outcomes to guide our interdisciplinary learning. 'Exploring Values and Attitudes', we will look at how we can help to make a positive difference in our local community.

Our key question is:

→How can we be 'Superheroes' in our own and surrounding community?

The Curriculum

'the totality of all that is planned for children and young people throughout their education'

Each term we will plan opportunities for how we contribute to the ethos and life of the school as a community.

Pupils will have the opportunity to participate in decision making when discussing moral dilemmas when discussing racism (linked to class novel).

Our class novel this term is Divided City; we will be using this to explore Emotion Works (Health & Wellbeing and linking with literacy and school values. We will focus on the purple (influences) and grey (intensity) cogs, in particular.

We are taking on new roles and responsibilities within the school community for example, buddying duties and helping in the lunch hall.

In term 1 pupils will be learning the following in each curricular area:-

Numeracy – we will be using a range of numerical operations with numbers of varying values.

Maths – Name angles, identify types of angles and calculate missing angles.
