Use an old newspaper or magazine (ask permission first) Find and cut up the letters that make up some of your spelling list words.	Use what you have learned in Maths to help you find 2D shapes in the environment. eg window- rectangle	Try to taste some new food. Give the new food a mark out of 10. How many new things can you try?	Go for an Autumn walk around your home and write down the names of objects you see for each letter of the alphabet. i.e. a-apple tree, b-bark, etc.	Play a board game with your family.
Try and read at least two books at home this term. Bring one in to share with the class.
