Share on twitter some photographs of a day you have had with your family where you learned something new.	Make a nice card for someone in your class. You can sign it if you wish. Bring it in and surprise them with your lovely picture.	Use https://www.doorwayonline.org.uk/literacy/letterformation/ to practise your letter formation.
Practise writing your numbers to 20 in different ways (e.g. with chalk outside, in shaving foam or sand, using sticks or materials you find outside, use paints or different coloured pens).	Do you know what a plant needs to grow? Plant seeds/bulbs at home and tell the class about it. You could take a picture of the different stages to see how it grows.	<u>Primary 1 Home Learning January – April 2020</u> Here are some activities you may like to do at home this term. You can do them at any time and in any order.	Can you show someone at home how to wash your hands properly? Why is it important to keep your hands clean? When is a good time to wash your hands?	Play a game with someone at home and practise taking turns and sharing.

Think of something kind you have done today. Talk about a random act of kindness you would like to do at home!	Practise using your manners at home. (e.g. chalk, paint, pens, on someone's back with your finger, on the side of your bath with your fingers).
